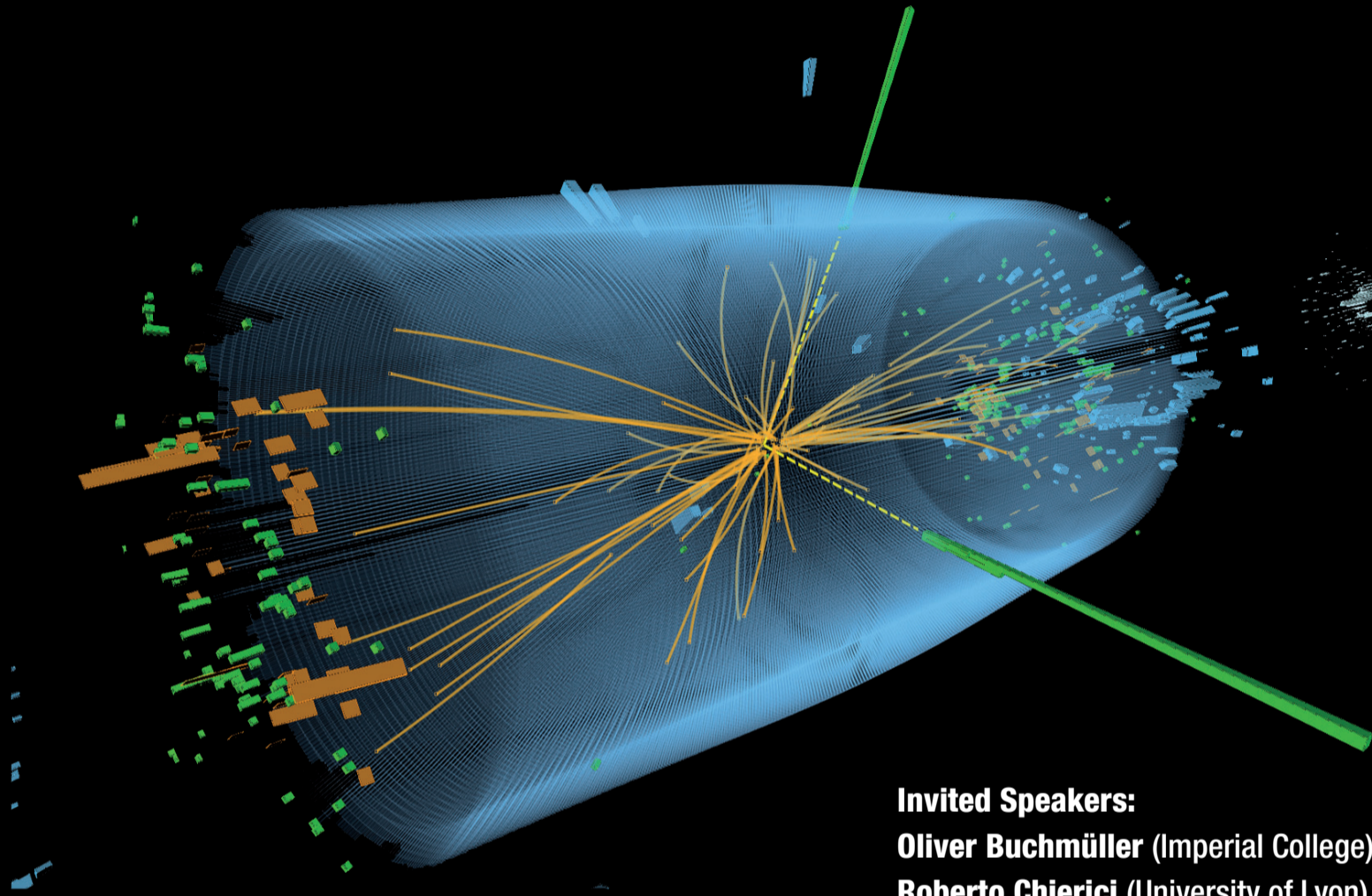

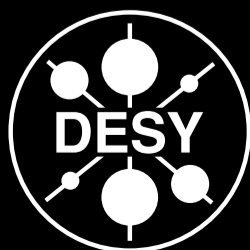


The aim of the seminar is to foster the scientific dialog between young academics and senior scientists by offering numerous occasions for individual discussions.
